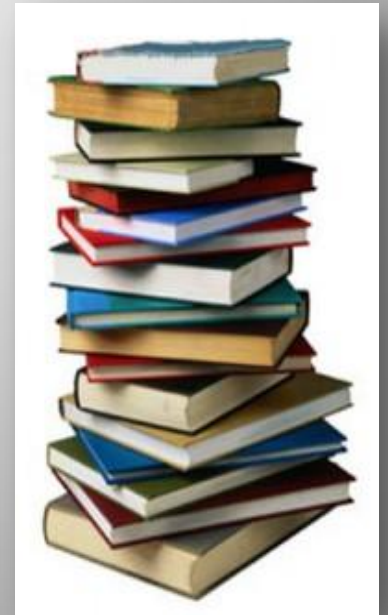
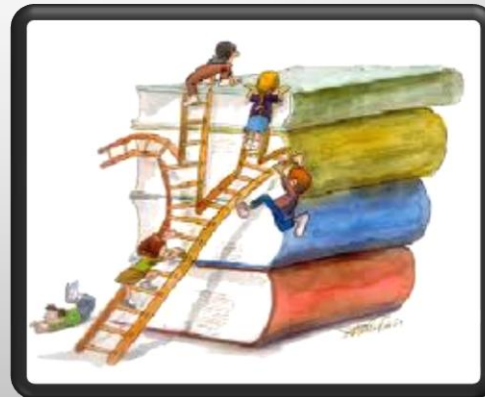
Primary education

- Primary education consists of 2 levels
 - **Kindergarten** (nipiagogeio) which lasts 1 or 2 years and
 - **Primary school** (dimotiko) which lasts 6 years (ages 6 to 12)



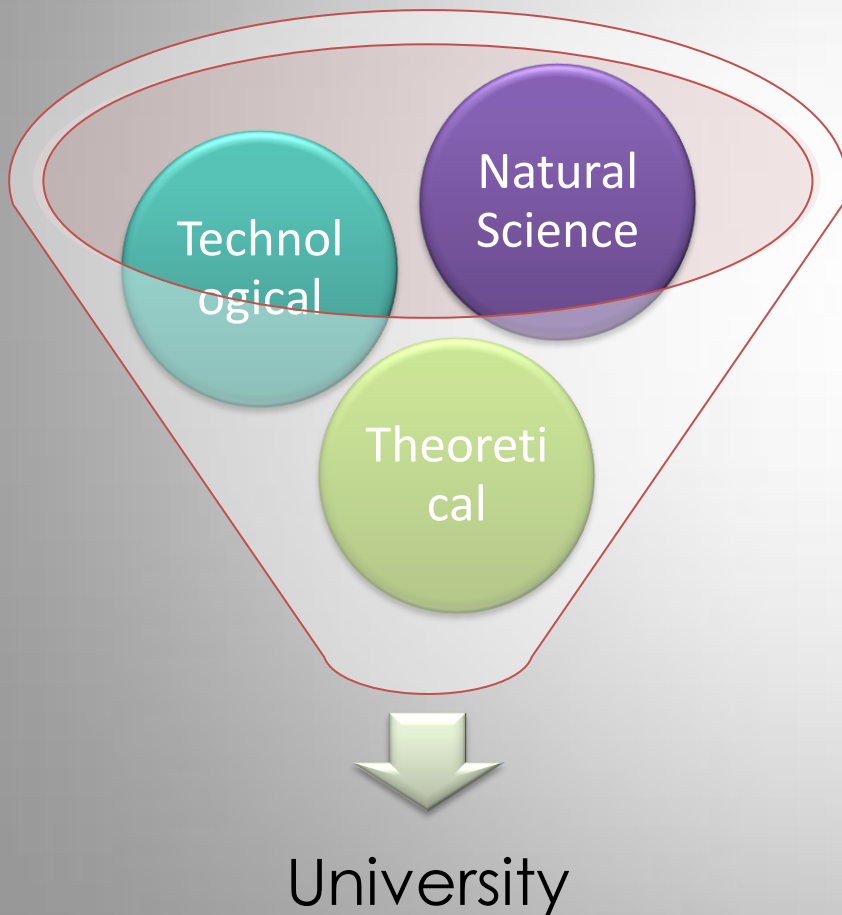
Secondary education

- Secondary education has 2 levels:
 - **High School** (gymnasio) which is compulsory and lasts 3 years
 - **Senior High School** (lykeio) which lasts 3 more years
 - the **General Lyceum** (Geniko Lykeio) and
 - the **Vocational Lyceum** (Epaggelmatiko Lykeio)

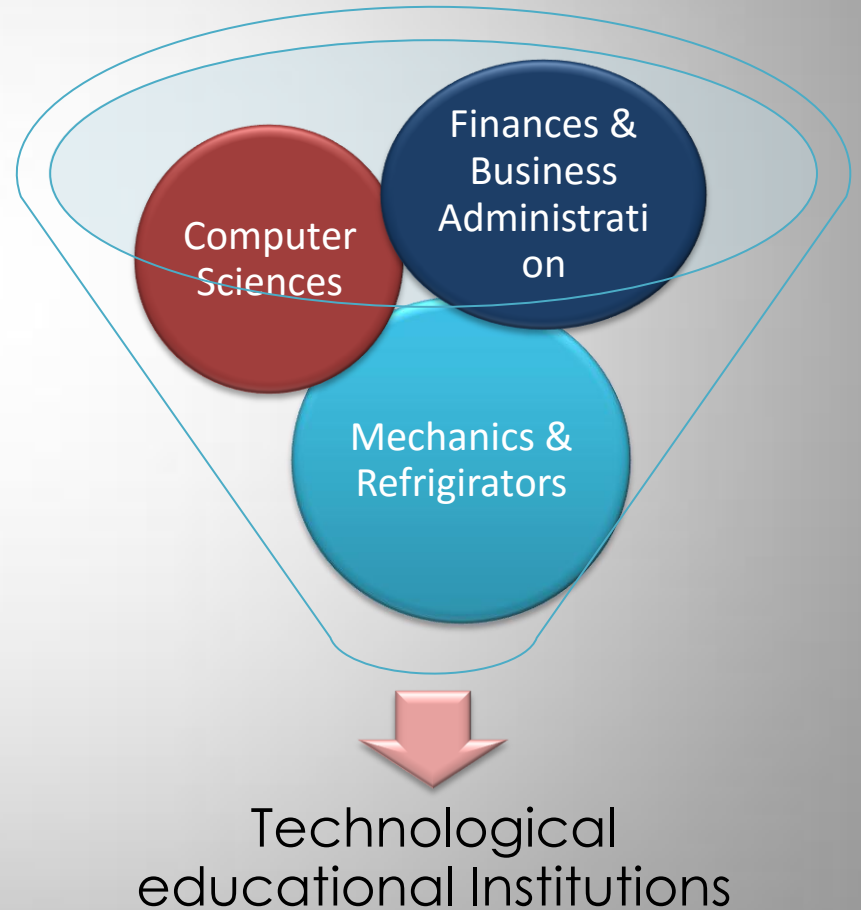


Differences

Higher Education
